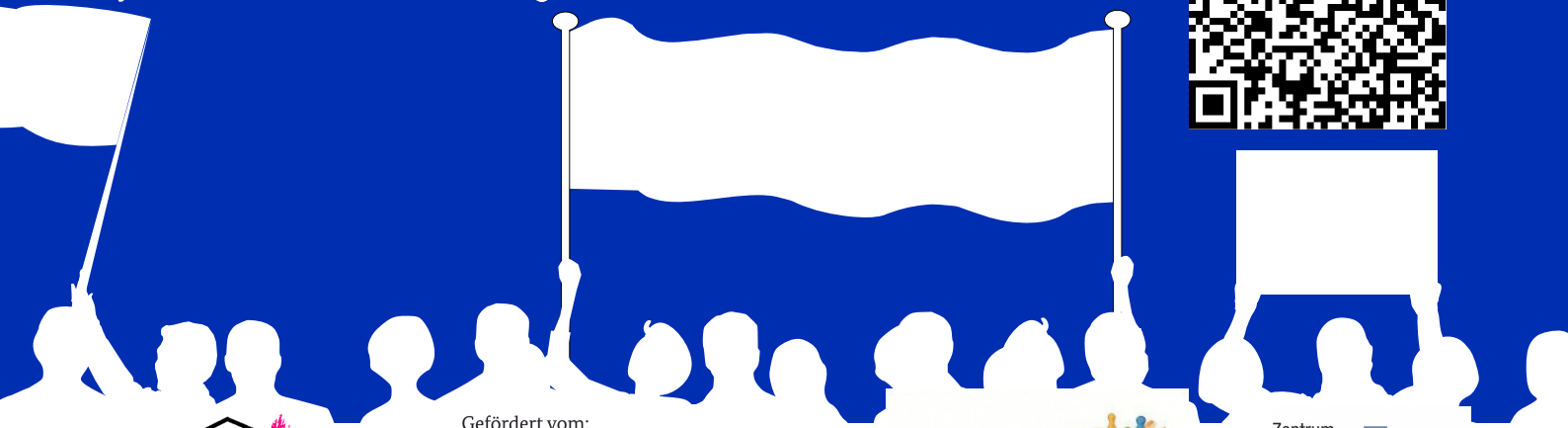
**Meet young people from across
